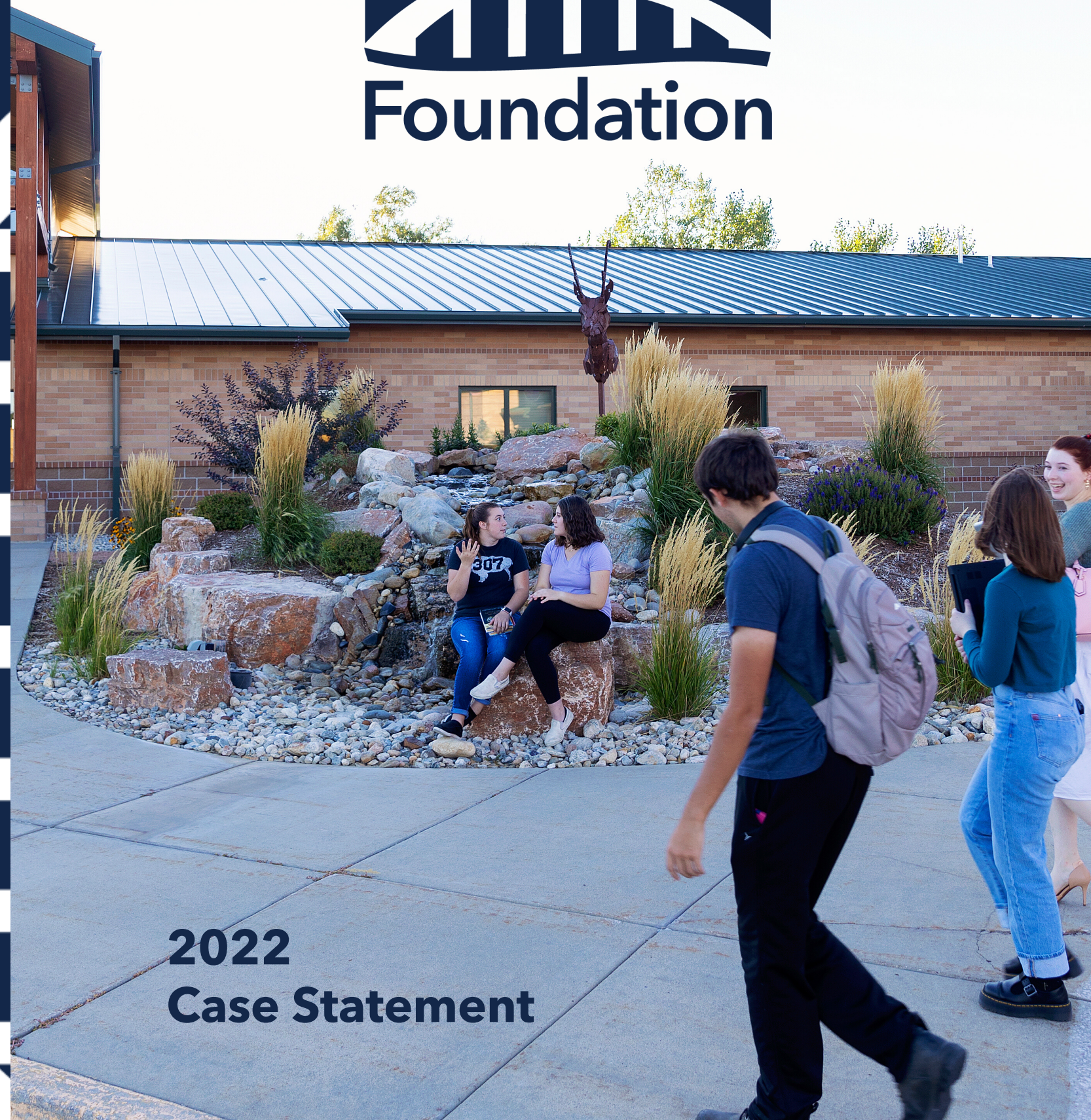

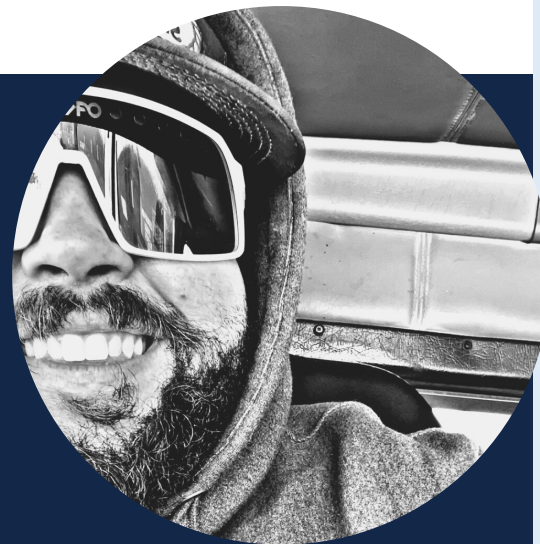
Echo Roush
