Newly enrolled students in a healthcare career pathway *may be eligible* for up to \$10,000 toward the cost of completing a qualified healthcare program within a 2-year timeframe. Preference will be given to those enrolled in a Nursing Pathway or Behavioral Health Pathway; however, other healthcare career pathways are also eligible.



## ELIGIBILITY

**WyHealthTrain Grants** may be available to Wyoming residents who are:

- Newly enrolled for the upcoming semester in eligible healthcare-related academic programs provided by a Wyoming Community College or the University of Wyoming **and who also meet one or both of the following criteria:**

- Became unemployed or underemployed during or as a result of the pandemic (March 13, 2020 – May 11, 2023).

Household income is at or below 300% of the federal poverty guidelines.

## HOW TO APPLY

- The first application window will be November 1, 2023 through December 8, 2023, for those enrolling for the Spring 2024 semester.
- The second application window will be mid April through May 31, 2024 for those enrolling for the Fall 2024 semester

## TIPS FOR A GOOD APPLICATION

- Prepare ahead of time by meeting with your advisor and gathering:
  - Course list required for graduation/completion of identified program
  - Total cost of tuition/enrollment
  - Total cost of books, supplies, and fees
  - Start date and end date for completion of degree or certification
  - Acceptance letter into a healthcare related program if applicable
- Take your time – do not rush just to be the first to get your application in.
- Full and complete answers will help the review team better understand your interest and chosen career pathway.
- Preference is not given to first-received applications, all eligible applications will be reviewed.
